Position Purpose

The area director, under the leadership of the ministry director, will be primarily responsible for the YFC ministry that takes place in a certain geographic area. This includes the development of volunteer and staff teams, community relations, fund development, and participation in the YFC ministry leadership team.

Key areas of this position include, but are not limited to:

- Casting vision for YFC Ministry.
- Recruiting, training and empowering a team of volunteer ministry leaders. This includes both Ministry Site Coordinators and Ministry Site Volunteers.
- Create a small support team (sometimes called a Community Support Team [CST]) who will do a few small development / volunteer recruitment events a year specifically for your area (I.E. see the story desserts, backyard parties, info nights, etc. As well as being another voice in the community.
- Encouraging/pastoring/coaching the volunteer teams in their roles, providing leadership guidance to the Ministry Site Coordinator.
- Working with the Ministry Leadership Team to create and provide streamlined trainings and other ministry tools to be shared across the chapter. Then to implement those in your ministry area.
- Working with your Ministry Site Coordinators to ensure the mission and vision of YFC are being met through the core ministries being implemented. This includes seeing lost kids involved in the ministry, kids coming to know Christ, kids being discipled and planted in local churches, and kids becoming lifelong followers of Christ.

All YFC employees have a responsibility to raise funds for the mission of YFC. You will be given the opportunity to be involved in the development functions of WSYFC. These opportunities could include fund raising events, circle of influence/YFC donor contacts, and other opportunities as provided.		
 Because the overriding religious purpose and mission of Youth for Christ USA is to communicate and introduce the Gospel of Jesus Christ to young people and their families, and in that regard to make, educate, and encourage life-long disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ, it is very important that you as an employee in the movement of Youth for Christ be recognized as an associate minister of the Gospel. As an employee of Youth for Christ and an associate minister of the Gospel, YFC expects all employees to: Seek God's guidance and wisdom, through prayer and meditation, for the organization as a whole as well as for specific ministry initiatives. Participate and lead regular times of prayer, devotion and worship as a regular aspect of your role within YFC. Teach and preach from the Holy Bible at YFC staff meetings, conferences, camps and events. 		

Additionally, YFC employees will have an opportunity to be commissioned or licensed as a minister of the Gospel through the established Youth for Christ process, and/or ordained by an outside body recognized by Youth for Christ USA. As such, the following additional responsibilities of a spiritual nature will apply to this position:
Perform sacramental functions such as the taking of communion and leading times of corporate prayer, confession and praise.
Perform and lead religious ceremonies such as weddings, baptism and funerals when called upon by staff and other members of the YFC community.
